MAC 411: Distinguish your VIPs in Mail

Q: My iPad's mail app shows a new VIP mailbox with iOS 6; my Mac (running OS 10.8) also shows a VIP mailbox in the mail application.

What are they; how do I set up and use them?

— BP of Naples

A: As you suspect, VIP stands for Very Important Person (or People). The purpose is to let you easily see email messages (from those associates you designate as VIP) in a mailbox separated from the clutter of your inbox (or other mailboxes). The VIP mailbox is a smart mailbox in both mail apps, so the message remains in its original location and is just viewed in the VIP mailbox. A prior article (tinyurl.com/82pfrvu) covered some limitations of mail in iOS and differences from mail in OS X.

Implementations of the VIP function in iOS 6 and OS 10.8 also have differences. The remainder of the article will address these.

VIP in Mail: OS 10.8

It is quite easy to add an an associate to the set of VIPs in mail for OS 10.8. First open a message from the person so the message is showing the name and email address. (This would be the top line, the "from" field.) If you look to the left of the name, there is a star icon.

Click on the star and a VIP folder will appear under the inbox mailbox of the set of mailboxes. (You also can right-click on the name to select add to VIP. In some cases, the right click works on names in the "to" field.)

The VIP folder displays messages in two ways. If you click the folder, all messages of all your VIPs are displayed. If you click on the flippy triangle, each VIP has a separate entry to view messages of that VIP. You might have to click on several sets of messages if one of your VIP associates uses multiple email addresses or names.

The VIP smart mailbox works across most mailboxes in mail. In Mac mail, it shows only messages from the VIP. Fortunately, it doesn't show messages in the trash folder.

The procedure to remove a VIP also is easy. Select one of the messages and click on the star icon or right-click to see "remove from VIP." You are not deleting the messages; you are merely not viewing them in the VIP mailbox.



VIP in Mail: iOS 6

The procedure for creating a VIP is different in your iDevice. A VIP mailbox is shown in the sidebar display of inboxes. Assuming you haven't created a VIP, you tap on the > at the right side of the VIP inbox. You will be presented with a screen and an add VIP tap point. Tapping that opens a listing of your contacts; use the search area to locate the associate you want to make a VIP. Tap on the contact name and it becomes a VIP.

Once you have a VIP identified, tapping on the > creates a slightly different display. All your VIPs are listed and the add VIP option remains. In addition, there is an opportunity to tap VIP alerts and add notifications whenever you receive a message from one of your VIPs.

The VIP smart mailbox apparently only works across the inboxes of your iDevice; this is one minor difference from how VIP works in OS 10.8. There is one, potentially, major difference. The IP smart mailbox in iOS 6 also displays any message that your VIP was copied on. Thus you will see messages from others than your VIPs!

The procedure to remove a VIP is straightforward. Tapping the > in the VIP mailbox will show the listing of VIP names. At the top right, tap the edit item and a – will display to the left of each VIP name. Tap the – and confirm the deletion.

iCloud and VIP

The VIP contact creation (or deletion) is synchronized through iCloud. Create a VIP in OS 10.8 and it will become a VIP in your iDevices; those created in an iDevice will show in your OS 10.8 computer.

There appears to be a bug about deletion across iCloud. VIPs created in an iDevice cannot be deleted in OS 10.8. However VIPs created in OS 10.8 can be deleted in an iDevice.

Khan Academy Releases New App for iPhone & iPod Touch, Mobile Access to 3600 Videos

Non-profit Khan Academy, an organization dedicated to "providing a free worldclass education for anyone anywhere," does so primarily through online video courses and lectures. The over 3600 videos are free and access is open to anyone (anywhere), allowing K-12 students to study math, science, computer science, finance & economics, humanities, and test prep. The organization was founded in 2006 by MIT and Harvard grad Salman Khan, who began by tutoring relatives and friends in Bangladesh while he worked as a hedge fund analyst in the States. His videos became so in-demand that he decided to quit his job and distribute them full-time, funded by donations from individuals and major donors like the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

While there is a healthy amount of skepticism about the efficacy of Khan's methods, there's no shortage of demand for the kind of instruction he offers to students all over the world. To further meet that demand, Khan Academy has just released an app for iPhone and iPod Touch. Unlike the app released this past March for the iPad, the iPhone version does not allow interactivity. Users can view videos but cannot, as with the iPad app, download playlists, read subtitles, and log progress, making this version "more for consumption rather than full interaction." Nevertheless, and whether critics like it or not, this represents a further step for distance learning, as education increasingly moves out of the classroom and into the handheld devices of networks of students no longer restricted by geography or physical mobility.

Apple Hard Drive Recall

Donald learned of this from Brad and passed it along to us: I just entered my serial number and my Mac is due for a NEW hard drive!! Well at least It didn't fail yet!!!! I have to bring it to an Apple store... I will keep every thing backed up and I guess call them and see what is the best time.

Brad stumbled across this on the apple website: it's a hard drive recall on iMacs. Apple has determined that certain Seagate 1TB hard drives used in 21.5-inch and 27-inch iMac systems may fail. These systems were sold between October 2009 and July 2011.

Apple or an Apple Authorized Service Provider will replace affected hard drives free of charge. Apple is contacting affected iMac owners who provided a valid email address during the product registration process to let them know about this program. If you have not been contacted, but think you have a 1TB Seagate hard drive, you can enter your serial number below to see if it's part of this program.


