Intellectual Property Law

(which includes copyright, patents, and trademarks)





Under intellectual property law, owners are granted certain exclusive rights for a certain amount of time

Owner automatically inherits copyright for new content

The owner sets restrictions on how that content may be used

Public Domain simply means
there is absolutely no
ownership (no copyright) of the
intellectual property

Translation: You can do anything you want with this material





Types of FREE

Content: Unrestricted Use







(1) if the intellectual property rights have expired

(2) if the intellectual property rights are forfeited

(3) if they are not covered by intellectual property rights at all.





Types of FREE

Freemium

Freemium is a business model that works by offering a product or service free of charge; while charging a premium for advanced features, functionality, or related products and services.





Types of FREE

Freemium

- Feature limited
 - (e.g. a "lite" version of software)
- ·Time limited
 - (e.g. only usable for 30 days)
- ·Capacity limited
 - (e.g. for an accounts package, can only be used to create 10 invoices)
- ·Seat limited
 - (e.g. only usable on 1 computer rather than across a network)
- •Customer class limited (e.g. only usable by educational users)
- Required to watch an advertisement
